

2015 Hawaii Trampoline Championships





The Hawaii Trampoline Championships have been held each year since 1999 to rank trampoline gymnasts for advancement to regional, national, and international competitions. Elites perform twisting double and triple somersaults while all others do jumps with single somersaults and are divided by age division. In addition to these categories the overall best performers regardless of age or skill level perform in the 'finals' for the overall best male and female awards. The three competitive events are: trampoline (TR), double mini-trampoline (DMT), and power tumbling (TUMB).

Results: Overall the top four trampoline gymnasts in Hawaii are:



Sydney Senter (13, Hawaii Baptist Academy, 6th grade, Aiea), US and Japan National Champion is also the current (2014) Age Group World Champion in double mini-trampoline, is ranked in Hawaii the best female on both TR and DMT.



Alexander Paul (13, Moanalua Middle School, 7th grade, Salt Lake), Japan and US National Champion and bronze medalist in the 2015 World Age Group Championships, is ranked in Hawaii the best male on both TR and DMT.



Maia Amano (13, Saint Andrews Priory, 6th grade, Manoa) is new to the elite level this year and is ranked in Hawaii 2nd among all females on both TR and DMT.



Julia Wilson (16, Aiea High School, Aiea), trampoline gymnast and veteran national competitor, is ranked in Hawaii 3rd among all females on both TR and DMT

Other

This year 53 gymnasts competed from the **Pearl Harbor Gymnastics Program** (all military families). The overall 'Best Military Performer' was **Jasmine Eustaquio** (14). The overall 'Most Inspirational Gymnast' was **Dr Kim Kepner-Sybounmy** (49). 'Hawaii's Most Outstanding Routine' on trampoline was performed by **Alexander Paul** (13). It started with a twisting triple somersault, had two $1^1/2$ twisting doubles, and ended with two double twisting doubles. (His best routine is one of the most difficult in the world for his age – it contains 21 flips and 10 twists in 10 bounces).
